Meeting:

Spring Cleanup will still be held May 16th. Lists of tasks will be posted by the board in a Google Excel spreadsheet – with suggested staged hours to avoid contact with others. We will not be tracking people's participation, but we suggest that everyone tries to do what they feel comfortable with. Let us know if you notice anything else that is needed. We will not be creating lists of tasks that require purchasing supplies.

Tree in lower cluster was successfully taken down, we may want to plant something small around it, but any major projects will need to be deferred.

Trees in middle cluster require replanting, we are due to find a solution given the amount of time that has passed since we took them down and our commitment to replanting in our application to Reston Association. We have drawings from Meadows Farms that need to be significantly scaled back down to fit in our budget and to fit our objectives. Heather has two sets of drawings – will pass it on to Nick Grainger who is a former Landscape Architect – who has offered his assistance. We will set up a budget around \$3500 max, given the savings we experienced in snow removal.

Trash pick up and recycling pick up has been spotty in the last few weeks, but there is no pattern to it. We are monitoring it.

Silver Prius in middle cluster has been parked without license plates for over two weeks. The middle cluster residents were all asked – and no one has claimed it. The police have confirmed that it is not stolen, but until the Cluster sends an official letter to the police – they can not tow it or contact the owners. Mark will send an email to all Wainwright residents asking for someone to claim it within a week. (Car belongs to owner who just purchased and can't get tags since DMV is closed)

Similarly there has been a large Airstream trailer parked on Wainwright drive outside the upper cluster parking lot, causing difficulty with visibility driving out of the parking lot. Mark will also send an email to residents to alert them that it may be ticketed or removed if no one removes it in the next week – trailers are not allowed to be parked on the road.
