- **3.** Lower Cluster ivy. Has regrown. Suggest Mr. T comes back for additional weeding and ivy removal.
- **4. Tree Work.** Dead pine behind 1711, plus some miscellaneous cutting (limbs in middle cluster, trimming near homes). Quote for \$3k \$4k. Motion to approve the budget was made, seconded, and approved.

New Business

- 1. Cluster Handbook, time to update. Damien is still in progress.
- 2. **Garbage cans no lids.** Warning letters will be posted for those residents who have not yet purchased covered trash cans. Recommend replacing open recycling bin with closed one. Snap on lids are available at most hardware stores.
- 3. Lower Cluster trash by entrance not allowed. This has improved. Large garbage should not be placed in this spot until the day before trash pickup. You can also call ahead to AAA (703-818-8222) to schedule a pick-up, take it directly to the dump, or schedule a pickup by a Junk Removal companies (such as Junk Be Gone promotional fee of \$25).
- 4. Upper cluster trash by street. Has been removed.

- There is a tremendous amount of fungus growing in the middle cluster, resident expressed concerns about mold and fungus spores. Landscaping committee to contact Meadows for advice about removal methods.
